1. The Nature of God	God is triune, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is uncreated, holy, righteous, just, and unchanging. God's omnipotence, omniscience, and omnipresence reflect His divine sovereignty over creation.	Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 6:3; Revelation 19:6
2. Scripture	The Holy Bible, composed of 66 books, is God's inerrant and inspired Word, authored through the Holy Spirit. It is foundational for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, fully equipping believers for every good work. The Scriptures testify of Jesus Christ, revealing the path to salvation.	2 Timothy 3:16-17; John 5:39

3. Jesus Christ	<p>Jesus Christ, fully God and fully man, lived a sinless life on earth. Born of the Virgin Mary, He performed miracles, taught the truth, and provided the ultimate sacrifice for sin through His death on the cross. He rose bodily on the third day, ascended into heaven, and will return in glory. His redemptive work offers forgiveness and new life to all who believe.</p>	<p>John 1:14; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4; Colossians 2:9</p>
4. Salvation	<p>Salvation is a gift from God, received through faith alone in Jesus Christ. It is an instantaneous and irreversible act initiated by God through the Holy Spirit, who regenerates the sinner, enabling them to respond to the gospel. This faith results in completely forgiving all sins—past, present, and future—and secures the believer's eternal destiny.</p>	<p>Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:5</p>
5. The Church	<p>The church is the body of Christ, a global community of believers tasked with worshiping God, edifying one another, and proclaiming the gospel. It serves as a moral and spiritual lighthouse in society, demonstrating God's kingdom through acts of love, mercy, and justice.</p>	<p>Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:42-47</p>
6. The Holy Spirit	<p>The Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity, indwells all believers who have received the baptism of the Holy Spirit, serving as the seal of their salvation and the empowerer of their witness. He convicts the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment. The Spirit guides believers into all truth and bestows spiritual gifts for the edification of the church and the fulfillment of its mission.</p>	<p>John 14:26; 16:8-13; Acts 8:15-17; Ephesians 1:13-14</p>
7. Eschatology	<p>The end times will unfold according to the literal prophetic scriptures in Daniel, Revelation, and other prophetic writings. Believers will be raptured before a seven-year tribulation, followed by Christ's thousand-year reign. This ends with Satan's defeat and the Great White Throne Judgment, leading to a new heaven and new earth where God dwells with His people forever.</p>	<p>1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; Revelation 20:1-15</p>

8. Sacraments	Water baptism is an act of obedience following faith in Christ, symbolizing death to sin and new life in Jesus. Baptism in the Holy Spirit may occur simultaneously with or after water baptism, manifesting in spiritual gifts. Both are acts of faith but not requirements for salvation.	Matthew 28:19; Acts 1:8; 2:38
9. Humanity and Sin	Humanity, created in God's image, fell into sin through Adam and Eve's disobedience, inheriting a sinful nature and moral corruption. This total depravity makes people incapable of returning to God without divine intervention. Salvation through Jesus Christ is the only remedy for sin, restoring relationship with God.	Romans 5:12; 3:23; Ephesians 2:1-5
